- Operating Hours: OSHC operates between the hours of 7.30am and 6.15pm. Children who are not picked up after 6.15pm may incur late fees.
- Fees: \$60.00 per in day \$70.00 per day on Excursions, per child, from January 2024 the fees will be \$65 per in day and \$75.00 for Excursions. This is our full fee without Government Assistance. Any fees for January for a child in year 7 in 2024 will need to be paid in full prior to bookings being confirmed.

- What to Bring: Please ensure that you send a RED OSHC hat, drink bottle, recess and lunch for your child/ren.



Food: Please refer to the program for when extra food or lunch is provided. When meals/snacks are provided we ensure we meet the needs of all children.

- Medication: Please communicate if your child has developed a medical condition or any changes concerning your child's medication. If your child requires medication please make sure you have completed an up to date care plan. Please see staff to discuss further.
- Clothing: Please send your child/ren in sun smart clothing and a RED hat, suitable for the weather conditions. OSHC does NOT provide spare hats for children. All children are required to wear appropriate footwear, and to provide a change of clothes when there is a water play activity or if your child is likely to have a toileting accident.

NOTE: A rash top or T-Shirt is required for all water activities



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Please provide enough healthy snacks for your child. No lollypops due to being a choking hazard.

• <u>Allergies:</u> We have children enrolled in our service that have allergies to nuts, please make sure that you do <u>NOT</u> send your child/ren with products that

contain nuts.
